Jim Lovinski, Executive Director of the Lamoille Housing Partnership was present to discuss his options of installing net metered housing in the trailer park in Hardwick now that HED has reached its cap. Following discussion, it was voted to authorize the Manager to move forward with negotiating a purchase power agreement with the terms that consist of price based on avoided costs, for a term of 10 years, terminable on 60 days notice by the customer, terms that are generally consistent with the technical requirements similar to current Hardwick Electric net metering customers.

**NET METERING**

The Manager updated the Board on the current happenings at Hardwick Electric. The hydro lifelines that were damaged in the flood will be replaced soon. The Manager and Commissioner Gedanken had a conference call with the developer of the H11 project and a site visit has been scheduled for the near future. The Manager updated the Board on the status of the new phone answering system and the manager will schedule a time them to come meet with the Commissioners.
